On June 12th, 2020, Governor Cuomo tasked all law enforcement agencies in the state to embark on a process to examine procedures and reform them to better meet the needs of their respective community. The emphasis of this is to be placed on social issues and fairness in the application of law. In order to establish the needs of the community best, we are seeking members of the public to participate in a virtual meeting on Thursday, February 4th, 2021 at 6:00 PM, to voice general concerns that have been observed from the North Greenbush Police Department. Unfortunately, this will need to be limited to 10 members of the public to ensure order on the virtual meeting however it will also be livestreamed via the Town website, TownOfNG.com, for public viewing.

North Greenbush residents are encouraged to send an email to Reform@NorthGreenbushPolice.Org which includes a name, address, best phone number to contact, and a short explanation on why they would like to be on the panel. This will help in the selection process. Those selected will be notified by phone no later than January 27th.

Residents who would like to express a concern rather than being on the panel are also encouraged to submit those concerns to that email address and they will be considered. Complaints about an individual officer or incident should use the existing avenues to make that complaint rather than this email address.

The deadline for submissions is 5:00 PM on January 22nd, 2021. We look forward to hearing from, and virtually meeting, as many of our neighbors as possible.
