He was arraigned at North Greenbush Town Court and remanded to Rensselaer County Jail on \$50,000 bail. He is to return to that court at a later date. *Sergeants Deeb, Peasley, Detective Walsh, Officers Gervais and Fleming*

3:09 PM- **Arrest**- 36-year-old Joseph Shook, of Castleton, was taken into custody at Rensselaer County Jail, where he was housed on unrelated charges, on an outstanding arrest warrant stemming from a shoplifting at Shoprite on September 24th, 2023. In that case, staff reported that three subjects had stolen \$541.61 in merchandise. Shook was identified as one of the subjects. He was charged with Petit Larceny and Conspiracy 6th degree, both misdemeanors. He was arraigned at North Greenbush Town Court and remanded back to Rensselaer County Jail on \$1 bail as he was already being held on other charges. He is to return to court at a later date. One of the other suspects had previously been arrested and there is an outstanding arrest warrant for the third. *Investigation by Officer Valenti. Arrest by Officer Verardi*
