Odell was charged with Robbery 3rd degree, Grand Larceny 4th degree, and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4th degree, all felonies. She was arraigned at North Greenbush Town Court and released to return back in that court at a later date. *Investigation by Detectives Stehr, Walsh, and Lieutenant Croll. Arrest by Detective Walsh, Officers Fleming, and Paterno*

11:58 AM- **Arrest-** Holly Rivers, of East Greenbush, turned herself in on an outstanding arrest warrant stemming from a dispute at Taco Bell on August 21st, 2024. In that case, it is alleged that she had begun an argument with the victim before throwing her drink on them. The victim reported that Rivers had made threats towards the victim and a family member. She was charged with Harassment 2nd degree, a violation, and released to appear in court at a later date. *Investigation and arrest by Officer Catlin*
