11:35 AM- **Citizen Assist**- At the station. A resident wished to speak to an officer about ongoing issues. *Sergeant Deeb*

1:11 PM- **Arrest**- Markus Jubrey, homeless, was taken into custody during a traffic stop on State Route 150 near Pershing Ave. following an investigation into a menacing complaint at a location on Main Ave. minutes prior. The victim and witness stated that Jubrey had approached them and tried to start a fight, despite them not knowing him. Jubrey allegedly threatened to shoot them and brandished what looked like a firearm before leaving the parking lot as a passenger in a vehicle. With the assistance of RCSO and Troy PD, the vehicle was located and stopped. Jubrey was taken into custody but no weapon was located in the vehicle. Jubrey was charged with Harassment 2nd degree, a violation, and released to appear in court at a later date. *Officers Catlin and Paterno*

2:16 PM- **Emotionally Distressed Person**- At Vanderheyden. Staff reported a juvenile male student in crisis. Officers spoke to the individual who agreed to go to the hospital by ambulance for a mental health evaluation. RCSO assisted. *Sergeant Deeb*

She was arraigned at North Greenbush Town Court and remanded back to the custody of Saratoga County Jail where she was being held on unrelated charges. She is to return to court at a later date. *Investigations by Officers Pollay, Clemenzi, and Catlin. Arrest by Officer Catlin*

10:31 AM- **Arrest**- Edward Charette, of Troy, was taken into custody at his residence on an outstanding warrant stemming from a March 17th, 2025 theft from Home Depot. In that case, staff reported that two males had left the store with \$199 worth of merchandise under their jackets. Charette was identified as one of the males through investigation.
