A blood sample was taken for chemical testing but the results are not available, yet. He was charged with Driving While Ability Impaired by Drugs, a misdemeanor, Speed Not Reasonable, Using Mobile Device While Operating a Vehicle, and Moved from Lane Unsafely, all infractions. He was released to appear in court at a later date. EGPD assisted. *Officer Clemenzi and Sergeant Peasley*

9:07 AM- **Arrest**- Austin Mason, of North Greenbush, turned himself in at the station on charges stemming from an investigation into a burglary on Koon St. on March 17th, 2026. In that case, the victim reported that an unknown male had entered their garage during the night and stole property. The investigation led to Mason being identified as the male.
