On initial contact, he had provided a fraudulent driver's license and an open container was observed in the vehicle. A license check revealed that his driver's license was revoked. Field sobriety tests were administered, which he failed, and he refused to submit a breath sample. He was charged with Forgery 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Possession of a Forged Instrument 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 1<sup>st</sup> degree, all misdemeanors, Driving While Intoxicated, a misdemeanor, Refusal to Submit to Breath Test, and equipment infractions. He was arraigned at North Greenbush Town

Court and remanded to Rensselaer County Jail without bail as a predicate felon. He is to return to that court at a later date. *Officers Clemenzi and Pollay*

3:33 AM- **Arrest-** Ralph Belcher, of Troy, was taken into custody by Troy PD and turned over to this agency on an outstanding arrest warrant stemming from an incident on July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024. In that case, officers were investigating a single vehicle property damage auto accident on Whiteview Rd. where the driver had fled. Belcher had been found in the area and was detained in the rear of a patrol car pending the investigation. That day, Belcher was released from custody without charges but a review of the patrol camera video revealed that he had gotten his handcuffs in front of him and was attempting to get the handcuffs unlocked before being disrupted by officers approaching the car again. He was charged with Criminal Tampering 3<sup>rd</sup> degree, a misdemeanor, and arraigned at North Greenbush Town Court where he was released to monitoring by Rensselaer County Probation. He is to return to that court at a later date. *Sergeant Peasley*
